## WORLD CHANGER – THE BODY OF CHRIST

We are in the world, and each day we have the opportunity as the part of the Body of Christ, to change it. Changing our world involves four fields of ministry for each of us. We read in Micah 6:8 that what God requires of us is to do justice, to love kindness and to walk humbly with your God. To walk humbly with your God is about self; to love kindness involves others; and to do justice involves your community and the world.

Our first task every day is to place into action our plan to anchor ourselves spiritually. We are instructed to repent and turn away from our old ways of life. To put this plan into action requires daily discipline. Before we can effectively change others, we must change ourselves. We have

to be careful as we do this and always to be led by grace so we won't become driven by rigid perfectionism and legalism; motivated by our own needs, relying on self rather than God, and running on empty because we don't have a vital relationship with God and other Christians.

Our model is Jesus. The ministry of Jesus came from His relationship with God and His close friends, the disciples. We can't have an effective ministry without using the same formula. We must withdraw to a quiet, lonely place and pray, as He so often did; and also share with our close Christian friends (reunion group). We begin by changing ourselves and sustaining that change in our heart (piety), our mind (study) and will (action).

We are called to give love

and mercy in our family, with friends, neighbors, co-workers and acquaintances. We are to blend the grace of Christ into each of these relationships by making mercy and outreaching love a part of our everyday life. Who do you know that needs your encouragement; who needs only what you can give; and who needs to hear about Christ from you.

We influence our communities by how we do or do not participate as a Christian. Our mission is to help Christ change our communities. Identify human needs and then work to correct the situation causing that need. Works of mercy and justice are both necessary. We must not only feed the hungry, but also find solutions to the reason and cause of the hunger. What

is your plan? Changing our world begins with one small step. Remember, some Christian's plant, other water and still others harvest.

When we accept Christ, we become new persons, with a common calling: the body of Christ. The body of Christ is the community of all disciples united by faith in Christ and who respond to His call to "follow me" and become fishers of men. Christ's ministry in the world today is only continued through the body of Christ, the church.

The greatest challenge of the church today is to empower and equip more of its members to engage in Christian action in their everyday lives. This has been, and is the goal and mission of the Walk to Emmaus since it's beginning; to raise up Christian leaders and renew the church as the body of Christ in action.

Each of us is a minister; laity and clergy alike are called to serve God. We are a team and we are always to serve together, never in competition. Every man, woman and child is an important member of the body of Christ. Every member of the body must realize that once-a-week Sunday church activities cannot compete with the influences of the world; we must have daily activities of piety, study and action.

The body of Christ is alive and life giving. The heart of the church is God's commitment to us in Christ and our commitment to God and to one another in Christ. Christianity is not a solitary practice, but rather powered by the Holy Spirit we become vessels whereby the ministry and grace of Christ is shared with the world. The body of Christ does not exist for its own existence, but for mission. The body breathes in piety and study and breathes out action. We gather for worship and nurture; then we scatter for witness and

humble service. We must always be intentional to witness to each other, and to the world.

Each of us, as a member of the body of Christ, has a part to play. We each need a plan. What need in the church, community or world is the spirit nudging you to do something about? What burden of love seems to always gain your attention and you want to make it your business? Each of us has been given the gifts and resources to respond to whatever the Spirit places on our hearts. We are surrounded with others in the body so we can work as a team together for His mission in this world.
