Alabama Emmaus is alive and well

At our annual Training Event, the Community Lay Director usually gives a report on the Community and how things are going. I was happy to report that Alabama Emmaus is alive and well. We will have 17 Walks again this year. We are averaging 46 pilgrims per Walk.

Some Walks have as few as 43 while others have as many as 54. This year between 780 and 800 pilgrims will attend a Walk at Camp Sumatanga! Think of the impact this will have on our churches.

At Alabama Emmaus, we have waiting lists for pilgrims. Some communities can't fill a walk for lack of pilgrims. At Alabama Emmaus, we have a pool of people who are qualified to be Lay Directors. Some communities have had to cancel walks or have people serve as Lay Directors more than once because they do not have enough people qualified.

At Alabama Emmaus, we have people who want to serve on the Board of Directors. Some communities have difficulty finding people willing to serve. At Alabama Emmaus, every Walk is an event of such significant proportion that 300-400 people come to Candlelight to support the pilgrims.

We have a new Agape Room that was completed in August and used for the first time on Walk 339. There were hundreds and hundreds of people who gave of their money and their resources and their time to make that happen.

The cost estimate came in at \$106,000. We were able to build it for about half that amount because of donations of materials and labor. Thanks to all who gave to make the Agape Room a reality.

We recognized one individual who took the Agape Room project by the horns and walked it through from day one to completion. He was at Camp nearly every day during construction and was there one stretch of every day for 6 weeks. It would not have happened if Bud Vann had not been willing to give of himself, at his own expense, to oversee this project from start to finish. Thanks, Uncle Bud! A permanent plaque will be placed in the Agape Room in his honor.

God has blessed and continues to bless our efforts on His behalf at Alabama Emmaus.

Since Walk 1 in 1982, all Alabama Emmaus Walks have taken place at Camp Sumatanga. Can you imagine an Alabama Emmaus Walk anywhere else? Alabama Emmaus and Camp Sumatanga are synonymous. We need them, and they now need us in a big way. It has become increasingly clear

The correct ingredients!

It is great to try new recipes. But I have found that with unfamiliar recipes I really have to be careful. Sometimes I find myself double checking and even checking for the third time to be sure I have added the correct ingredients and used the right measurements.

Believe me there is a big difference between a teaspoon of salt and a tablespoon of salt. And what would a cake taste like if I totally failed to add the sugar?

I think the same idea can be applied to sponsorship.

If we sponsor someone without first praying about it before approaching him or her to attend the walk, we have failed to turn the oven on to preheat. Prayer is the first ingredient for a good sponsor.

The same is true if we tell our pilgrims that they need to pack walking shoes and pack lots of snacks. We have completely changed the recipe. I could go on with many comparisons, but I think you can understand the recipe for good sponsorship.

The book simply entitled *Sponsorship* by Richard & Janine Gilmore is an ideal book to read before you commit to sponsor someone. This book is available through the Upper Room and is also available for purchase before our Candlelight and Closing services at Camp. I highly recommended it.

This might give ladies, who have recently attended their walk, an opportunity for their spouses to attend. Just be sure if they want to sponsor them they have an experienced co-sponsor that will be willing to guide them along.

that if Camp Sumatanga is to survive, it will be because of folks who have attended their Emmaus Walk at Camp Sumatanga.

For us it is Holy Ground. If we don't step up now to save the camp, it could just go away. Many have thought that the camp just needed some repairs and a general "fixing up." *That is not the case!* There are areas that have been patched so many times they can no longer be patched. The Camp needs major upgrading.

The Conference does not support the Camp financially to the level needed to be able to make the upgrades. Camp relies on donations and fees for camp services. It needs "heads in beds."

Some of our Clusters have decided to adopt a Camp project and provide funding for that project. A Cluster or a Cluster Grouping can take on a project for Camp and call it their own. The first thing that needs a major overhaul is the waste treatment plant. One Cluster has adopted that project. Another Cluster has voiced interest in the Retreat Center upgrades. Clusters are making cookbooks and hosting golf tournaments.

How about you? What can you do to help Camp Sumatanga survive? I am challenging all of us at Alabama Emmaus to **SAVE SUMATANGA**.

As I mentioned to those at the Training Event: after hearing of the Camp's needs, ask yourself- What can I do to help save Camp Sumatanga? Maybe we should ask ourselves two questions: 1. What does Camp Sumatanga mean to me? 2. What do I intend to do about it? Alabama Emmaus is alive and well, Camp Sumatanga is dying. If the Alabama Emmaus community comes together united, we can not only save Camp Sumatanga, we can preserve it for generations to come.
